You will also see from the news that the situation changes on an hour by hour basis and so our communications needs to be as fast as we can make it.

As a result, specifically referring to pandemic related emails, we will for a limited period, be communicating with you our members in a more direct way. This will mean that when a MOSA document is agreed by the Committee members then it will be sent to you directly by the MOSA Secretary. This is not intended to bypass the road reps but more of a way to decrease the time taken to get information to members.

However, from previous experience we understand that we need to resolve a potential problem before we proceed. We are aware of the problem of MOSA emails going into "Junk" when they have been sent. So, we are asking all members to check their "Junk" mail on a regular basis.

To try and overcome this problem, please add secretary@mosassociation.org as a contact. Help to do this can be found by searching for example "How to add a contact in gmail" - replace gmail by your email supplier, this could be suppliers such as 'outlook' or 'yahoo' etc. This should stop mail ending up in "Junk".

If you have already informed your Road Rep that you require hardcopies of all communications from MOSA, then please be assured that you will still receive all communications in hardcopy format.

We are hoping that these steps will if necessary, speed up communications with all of our Members during this difficult time.
